

## **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN**

### **CHICHESTER COLLEGE STATUS AS AN EXEMPT CHARITY**

Chichester College was created as a further education corporation under the provisions of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992. The Corporation assumed responsibility for the control of the College and its assets on 1 April 1993. Under the provisions of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992 the Charities Act of 1960 is amended to provide that a further education corporation shall be an exempt charity. As an exempt charity the Corporation does not need to apply for registration as a charity and therefore does not have a charity registration number (paragraph 69 of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992 refers).

Statutory Instrument 1992 No. 2097 confirmed that Chichester College of Technology (as it was then titled) was established as a further education corporation under the provisions of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992. The name was subsequently amended to Chichester College of Arts, Science and Technology and in August 2002 amended again to Chichester College on its merger with Brinsbury College.
