EXPRESS INTEREST

- » Contact us to express your interest and enquire course choice, accommodation availability, entry requirement, fee information, visa information, etc.

APPLY FOR COURSES

- » In order to process your application, the College requires:
 - ① Your completed student application form.
 - ② A copy of your passport.
 - ③ Evidence of your level of English as per course entry requirements.
 - ④ Other required documents specified in the course entry requirements.

PRELIMINARY BOOKING

- » The International Admissions staff will send you or your representative:
 - ① Conditional Offer
 - ② Proforma showing the indicative costs for your stay and studies. Payment details will also be on the proforma.

PAYMENT & CONFIRMATION

- » You will receive your booking confirmation after required payment is made:
 - ① Students applying for Student Visa, full fees for the first year of study are required to secure a place plus an additional fee of £21 for the CAS.

PAYMENT CONTINUED.

- ② Advanced Payment of Rent: £100. Following this payment, you will receive further information and documents you need to complete to confirm the accommodation booking.
- ③ Tuition fee deposit: £1,000 or full fees if your tuition fees are less than this. The balance and payment of full fees must be made no later than 4 weeks prior to the course start date.

VISA APPLICATION

- » Once booking is confirmed, the International Admissions staff will send you/your representative the relevant documents you need to support your visa application.

PRE-ARRIVAL

- » You must inform the College when your visa is issued and confirm your arrival date.
- » You must complete any remaining paperwork as mentioned if applicable.
- » Airport transfer can be arranged upon request at an additional cost.
- » Host family details may not be available at the time of application but will be given to you at least two weeks before your arrival.
- » You are welcome to download our latest Pre-Arrival Guide from our website and get ready for your travel.
