Allocation of accommodation depends on what is available when you apply. We advise that you apply early, stating both your first and second choices. If you have any specific requirements please add this to your application form.











Accommodation Team

The aim of the Accommodation Team is to ensure that all full-time students who require accommodation are provided with the best, most appropriate accommodation available.

To offer accommodation to those students who are unable to travel into the college each day. Priority in the under 18 residence (Woodlands) is for those who are studying with us for the full academic year.

CCG offers high-quality residential accommodation on Campus. There is one residence for those aged 16 - 17 at time of admission (Woodlands) and one for those 18 years or over at the time of admission (Westgate), with good train links to both Northbrook and Worthing campuses.

Homestay is also offered for students who are aged 16 and over at both our Chichester and Worthing campuses. With the majority of Host providers between 30 - 45 minutes travel time to your chosen campus. The care and support of students is our absolute priority and is maintained through the Accommodation Team with cover 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. There is a 24 hour out of hours' number always available. There is an excellent support network at the college including the safeguarding team, Accommodation Health care assistant, Accommodation & International Student Support Officers, College counselors, Student Tutors, first aiders and external agencies coming into the college. All services are available to all students.

The Accommodation Team is based in the Accommodation Office next to the College shop on the Chichester Campus. Please drop in at anytime for help and advice about finding suitable accommodation. Friendly advisors are always on hand to give you expert help and advice and to answer any questions you may have.

Woodlands Hall of Residence

Woodlands Hall of Residence provides secure on-campus accommodation for 90 students who are 16-17 years old at the time of admission at CCG

The under 18 guidelines are in place for the duration of the students' time at the residence. The Halls are staffed 24 hours a day by trained supervisors who provide excellent welfare support for all the residents.

There is a health care assistant available each day during the week located within Woodlands. They work closely with the Woodlands staff to make sure that all the support services that are available are offered to the students. The staff will assist all students to register with a local doctor, open a bank account and have all the tools they need to live in the halls.

Woodlands students attend a coaching session each week. These are a great way to support academic and personal growth and provide opportunities for the students to talk about important issues. Topics such as healthy eating and staying safe are covered. Woodlands comprises of single and twin bedded accommodation, many of which are en-suite. There are communal shower and toilet facilities on each floor. All rooms are well appointed with study facilities including storage space and Wi-Fi

Communal areas are cleaned each day, bedding and rooms each week. Facilities within the halls include a large communal area and games room, which include table tennis, pool and darts. There are also TV's and games consoles in the social spaces.

Woodlands have two laundry rooms for personal use. These are app operated machines. The app can be topped up within the halls so parents/guardians are able to do this too.

Catering for Woodlands' residents is on a full-board basis. Meals and snacks are available in the food court, the college shop and Costa. There are hot and cold water machines available 24/7, along with card operated vending machines. Woodlands is a 5 minute walk to the train station, with good transport links to both Northbrook and Worthing campuses.

There is a full enrichment package throughout the year with trips such as bowling, go-karting, paintballing, Harry Potter studios and Thorpe Park, as well as quiz nights, pool competitions and charity events, which are all included. Students are encouraged to be involved in the setting of the programme through surveys and by becoming a student rep, this is also a great way of making new friends.

Membership to the College's on-site gym, fitness classes and use of the tennis and basketball courts are included in the Woodlands' package.

There are CCTV cameras in the communal corridors in the Residence. This helps to create a positive and safe environment. Student's privacy is a priority and there is a clear CCTV policy in place. The full policy is available upon request.

Westgate Halls of Residence provides on-site, en-suite single accommodation for 160 students, 18 years and over at the time of admission.

There are rooms that have been specifically designed to meet the needs of students with a disability. There are members of staff on site at all times to settle you into your accommodation, whatever time of day you arrive.

Westgate Halls is available for both long and short term students who want the flexibility of not staying for the full academic year. Full board is available, please advise upon application.

There is a communal common room with TV, games console and Foosball table.

Bedding is included. Cooking utensils, & crockery are not provided, basic and premium starter packs can be purchased from Westgate prior to or upon arrival. Please see your welcome pack for more information.

An app operated laundry with washers and dryers is located on the premises.

Westgate is a secure building with a swipe card entry system for each block, flat and individual room. Wi-fi is available throughout the residence.

There is a halls supervisor available between 8:30am and 10pm every day. After 10pm a security warden is on duty for the Halls of Residence.

Communal areas are cleaned daily. Students are responsible for their own room and en suite facilities, along with being jointly responsible for maintaining a clean kitchen.

Membership to the College's on-site gym and fitness classes and use of the tennis and basketball courts is included in the Westgate package.

The student voice is an extremely important part of the college life. There is the opportunity to be a student rep for Westgate Halls. This is also a great chance to meet with other students in the residence and make new friends

Most homestay residence are within walking distance to either Chichester or Worthing campus, with some in the surrounding areas. Those outside the city are located on main bus or train routes.

The prices are all-inclusive and are very reasonable, with no extra charges for gas, electricity or Internet.

All homestay payments are made through the College to help maintain a friendly, homely environment.

Half-Board Option

Students live in the house with the Host provider and any members of their family and are treated as part of the family. Meals are provided and students usually eat with their host each evening. Perfect for International students who wish to practice their English language skills, or home students who want a family environment. Rooms are single occupancy only. A maximum of up to four students are permitted to stay in any one Homestay residence with no other student speaking the same language unless requested. Hosts provide breakfast and evening meals during the week, with the addition of lunch at the weekends. Laundry is included, although ironing is the responsibility of the students.

Accommodation Services will always endeavor to match your specific requirements with appropriate lodgings. For example, students can specify a smoking or non-smoking household, with or without pets and provision can be made for any dietary requirements, such as vegetarians, vegans or coeliac. The meals are included in the price, as is gas, electricity and laundry. Please note that unlimited Internet facilities are guaranteed with the Homestay option. Check with the Accommodation team for any further advice or information.



Rugby Academy Students

For those on the Rugby Academy at Worthing, we also offer homestay part week stays on a half-booard basis from 4 to 5 nights per week, which will be charged accordingly. We also offer the option to stay at our Woodlands Hall of Residence at our Chichester Campus on a 7 day per week option, with the easy commute to Worthing College by train. "You never feel like a stranger in the host family. You feel as though you're at home."


